On September 13, Congressman Ron Paul introduced **H.R. 2908 the Testimonial Free Speech Act**. Dietary supplement and other food companies are worried about sharing customer testimonials online because of FDA monitoring. I do not want the Federal government monitoring and curtailing the ability to have my personal testimony shared whether it is about my religious experiences, my shopping experiences or my health and wellness experiences. Every industry, from auto repair shops to hospitals, relies on the sharing of consumer testimonials to give potential customers the opportunity to hear first hand from other customers.

Unfortunately the US Food and Drug Administration is actively working to curtail the sharing of consumer testimonials by food/dietary supplement companies.

**Under H.R. 2908, FDA could not “...restrict dissemination of a testimonial containing a consumer’s actual perception of the mitigative, preventive, or curative properties of any food or dietary supplement based on the consumer’s experience with that food or dietary supplement.”**

Just as it is wrong for a government agency to monitor and control the free flow sharing of religious testimonials, it is equally as wrong to have a federal regulatory agency such as the FDA monitor and control the free flow sharing of consumer testimonials of foods and dietary supplements. Please help us stop this intrusion on liberty.
